<u>Uníform Swap Shop</u>

In the interests of sustainability and the Cost of the School Day, we will introduce a Uniform Swap Shop. This will be located in the school foyer. Any parent, carer or grandparent is welcome to come and help themselves to any uniform which is required. This will be particularly useful for children who have outgrown their current uniform and parents do not want the additional expense of replacing this for a few weeks of the summer term. The uniforms will be taken from the lost property items which have been there for some time and which do not have names. Parents also do not need to swap any item of uniform. Please take advantage of this so that we can be sustainable and save money at the same time. There will also be uniform available to purchase at the Summer Fete.

<u>School Uniform</u>

<u>Showcases of Learning</u>

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Post covid we have reintroduced Showcases of Learning so that parents can engage more in their children's learning. Each class will host a showcase this term if they have not already done so.

htdoor School Vísíts

Each class will participate in school visits which should link in with what they are learning in class. Our Cost of the School Day Statement has stipulated that whenever possible we will keep the cost of an outdoor visit to a maximum of ± 15 . However, due to the rising cost of transport

this has not always been possible. Next session, in order that we can subsidise school visits, we will arrange some kind of fundraiser.

Parent Helpers for Next Session
