



Settling-In Procedure

We are aware that a home to nursery transition can be stressful to both parent and child. We have found that a home visit and nursery pre-visit are helpful. Please speak to any member of the nursery team if you have any concerns or wish for a home visit.

A Pre-visit

When you come along to register your child you will be invited to view the nursery with your child at a suitable time.

Your child's first day at nursery

As a team we usually find that children settle after a few days however every child is unique and each settle differently. On your child's first day staff will be waiting to welcome you and your child into the room. When your child has settled at a particular task, tell him/her that you will wait in the Cloak Room while he/she plays. Parents will be asked to return after the hour. We recommend that they stay for approximately one hour for their first session. This gives parents time to complete some nursery paperwork. Staff will work together to agree a settling in programme to meet the needs of both child and parent. We will work closely with parents to ensure the transition meets the needs of all children.

Entrance/Exit of Nursery Building

The doors at the entrance to the nursery are on security entry. In order to enter the building you must press the buzzer and wait for a member of staff to let you in.

To exit there is a button located on the left hand side of the door which you must hold in before pushing the door. Please be vigilant and make sure that no other children enter or exit the building with you.
